Dear visitors,

I herewith would like to explain the purpose and the aim of the "Centre Le Corbusier" which was realized and is directed on an entirely private basis.

This Centre is the last building designed by the famous architect, city planner, painter and sculptor. It was inaugurated on July 15th, 1967. Various exhibitions, lectures and films have been presented so far and many more projects are being planned for the future. Besides presenting Le Corbusiers multifold work the Centre also intends to convey to the public ideas and suggestions as how to shape a better environment.

The following projects will be realized in the near future:

Exhibitions:

"Chandigarh" - The new city of Punjab, India, conceived by Le Corbusier. Inauguration on September 11th, 1968.

"Future architectonic and city planning projects". A survey of new possibilities for environmental planning.

"Nature must be preserved for mankind". - Exhibition in collaboration with the "World Wildlife Fund".

Lectures and films:

Every three or five weeks a series of lectures will be given on the topic "In search of a better environment". Experts from the fields of architecture, city planning, sociology etc. will personally present their viewpoints.



The film on "The realization of the Centre Le Corbusier" will be shown at regular intervals.

Furthermore, a film week on architecture will be organized.
